On behalf of the State of Montana, I am submitting this request for an extension to complete the conditions associated with the Resolution 20606. This resolution was approved June 8th, 2020. Following is a list of conditions with a status of each. The primary purpose of the extension request is the need for additional time to disconnect all service connections from the 48" Storm Main. One of those remaining connections is internal to the existing Historical Society Building. The other two connections are curb inlets on 6th Avenue. While the new infrastructure is in place to receive those connections, this work is not scheduled until summer/fall of 2021.

2E	All pending taxes and special assessments levied against the properties affected by the proposed vacation must be paid in full. Applicant shall furnish proof of payment of these taxes and special assessments.	Complete
2F	Applicant shall pay a \$165,571.70 transfer fee as required by Section 7-1-7 of the Helena City Code for the 28,063 square feet of vacated right-of-way. This fee must be paid prior to filing the amended plat and recording the Quit Claim Deed transferring title to Applicant.	Complete
2G	The amended plat must be filed and the Quit Claim Deed recorded with the Clerk & Recorder of Lewis & Clark County, Montana. The vacation is effective only upon the filing of the amended plat and recording of the Quit Claim Deed.	In-Progress. Per above.
